Created in 1946, ICOM is a non-governmental organisation (NGO) maintaining formal relations with UNESCO and having a consultative status with the United Nations' Economic and Social Council.

As a not for profit organisation, ICOM is financed primarily by membership fees and supported by various governmental and other bodies. It carries out part of UNESCO's programme for museums.

ICOM NZ is your National Committee of ICOM and we are looking to become more active, both here in NZ and internationally.

Currently NZ members are active in several International Committees and indeed serve on the board of both INTERCOM and ICAMT.
